

Big Head Big Slouch English



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This pattern is suited for anyone who's handknitted beanie is always too tight. Big Head Big Slouch is an oversized beanie that's easy to knit.

Materials:

1 skein The Odd Dodo Super Bulky (250gr - 137m) 9 & 10mm interchangeable circular needles with 40cm cable

Notions:

1 stitchmarker Tapestry needle

Explanation stitches:

Stockinette stitch - Knit all stitches knitwise on circular needles



Pattern Big Head Big Slouch

Cast on 42 stitches on the 9mm-40cm circular interchangeable needles. Place stitch marker and join in the round.

Row 1 [K1,P1] to stitch marker

Row 2-18 Repeat round 1 (your work should measure about 16cm now)

Change to the 10mm needles

Row 19-45 Knit in stockinette stitch (knit all stitches knitwise). Your work should measure about 18cm from the ribbed edge now.

We're starting the decrease now.

Row 46 *Knit 2 stitches together knitwise, knit 1 stitch* Repeat from * to * until the stitchmarker (28 stitches)

Row 47 Knit all stitches until end of row (28 sitches)

Row 48 Repeat row 46 and knit the last stitch knitwise (18 stitches)

Row 49 Repeat row 47

Row 50 Repeat row 46 (12 stitches)

Cut the yarn with a 20cm tail. Pull the yarn through the remaining stitches with the tapestry needle and pull tight. Bind off. Sew in any loose threads.
