Into The Woods



SIMPLE SEMI-CIRCLE WITH AN I-CORD BIND OFF

THIS PATTERN NEEDS:

6MM NEEDLES 5 SKEINS ARAN

OR

5MM NEEDLES 5 SKEINS DK



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Yarn:

Aran weight or DK weight (Sample is knit in Aran weight) 5 full 100gr skeins

Needles:

Aran: 6mm 80cm circular needles DK: 5mm 80cm circular needles

Tools:

2 stitchmarkers, tapestry needle

Abbreviations:

CO - Cast on CONT - Continue INC'D - Increased Sts - stitches K - Knit P - Purl YO - Yarn over PM - Place marker SM - Slip marker RS - Right Side WS - Wrong side C1 - Color 1 C2 - Color 2 etc..

Garter Tab Cast on

CO 3 sts with C1. Knit 8 rows. Turn work 90 degrees and pick up 4 sts. Turn work 90 degrees again and pick up 3 sts. You will have 10 sts on the needles.

Work and place markers: K3, pm, P4, pm, k3 (2 stitchmarkers total)

Repeat

Row 1 (RS): K3, sm, (K1, yo, K1) in 1 st, K until 1 st before marker, (K1, yo, K1) in 1 st, sm, K3 (4sts increased) Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, yo, p until marker, yo, sm, K3 (2st increased)

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for a total of 18 times

Join in with C2, do not cut C1

Fade

Repeat rows 1&2 with C2
Repeat rows 1&2 with C1
Repeat rows 1&2 with C2
Repeat rows 1&2 with C1. Cut C1 and continue with C2

Repeat Row 1 & 2 with C2 for a total of 12 times

Join in with C3, do not cut C2

Repeat <u>Fade</u> with C2 & C3 Cut C2 and continue with C3

Repeat rows 1 & 2 with C3 for a total of 8 times

Join in with C4, do not cut C3

Repeat <u>Fade</u> with C3 & C4 Cut C3 and continue with C4

Repeat rows 1 & 2 with C4 for a total of 6 times

Join with C5, do not cut C4

Repeat <u>Fade</u> with C4 & C5 Cut C4 and continue with C5

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for a total of 4 times

I-cord bind off

You can remove the stitchmarkers when you run into them.

Knit 2 stitches, slip the 3rd stitch knitwise, knit 1 more stitch. You have 4 stitches on the right needle. Use the left needle to pass the slipped stitch over the last knitted stitch. 3 stitches on right needle. Slip these 3 stitches back onto the left needle purlwise. Repeat until all stitches have been bound off

Weave in any lose ends with the tapestry needle. Block your shawl for the best results!
